Subject: Memo # 09-02: Reimbursement Rates Effective July 1, 2008 - June 30, 2009

This notice announces the annual adjustments to the national average payment rates for meals and supplements served in child care centers, outside-school-hours care centers, at-risk afterschool care centers, and adult day care centers. Note that the rate for Lunch/ Dinner does not include the cash-in-lieu of commodities rate, which sponsors receive as additional assistance for each lunch or supper served to participants.

The payment rates for the period July 1, 2008 - June 30, 2009 are:
