This notice announces the annual adjustments to the national average payment rates for CACFP meals and supplements served in child care centers, outside-school-hours care centers, at-risk afterschool care centers, emergency shelters, and adult day care centers. The rate for Lunch/Dinner does not include the cash-in-lieu of commodities rate, which sponsors receive as additional assistance for each lunch or supper served to participants.

The payment rates for the period July 1, 2012 - June 30, 2013 are:

<i>REMINDER: Meal Counts must be taken at the point of each meal service and recorded on the <u>Required Standardized Meal Count Form</u> designed by the Child and Adult Care Food Program office.</i>
