SUBJECT: **MEMO #10-02 – RATES OF REIMBURSEMENT (7/1/09 to 6/30/10)**

The annual adjustments to the nation average payment rates for meals served in day care homes and the administrative reimbursement rates for sponsors of day care homes have been published by the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA).

These rates of reimbursement are effective July 1, 2009 through June 30, 2010 for the Family Day Care Food Program. Rates are adjusted for inflation and rounded down to the lower whole cent for all meals served in both Tier I and Tier II day care homes.

NOTE: For the first time in the recorded history of the CACFP, rates of reimbursement for sponsor administrative expense reimbursement have declined. Therefore, we strongly recommend that all sponsoring organizations complete a re-assessment of their current and projected actual administrative costs versus projected homes times rates earnings for the current fiscal year. This re-assessment should take into account the decrease in administrative reimbursement rates for the final three months (July, August, and September) of the 2009 fiscal year. This may require that you modify the planned expenditures for the remainder of this fiscal year.
