Subject: Memo #12-02: Reimbursement Rates Effective July 1, 2011 - June 30, 2012

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This notice announces the annual adjustments to the national average payment rates for meals and supplements served in child care centers, outside-school-hours care centers, at-risk afterschool care centers, and adult day care centers. The rate for Lunch/Dinner does not include the cash-in-lieu of commodities rate, which sponsors receive as additional assistance for each lunch or supper served to participants.
